Mental Health Department

Our Role

- Serves as the local mental health authority coordinating the delivery of publicly funded community-based mental health services.
- Serves as the community's "safety net" for mental health needs.
- Serves as the "gatekeeper" to the State hospital

Who We Serve

- Adults with a serious mental illness (SMI)
- Children with a serious emotional disturbance (SED)
- Johnson County residents living with a SMI or SED who also have co-occurring substance abuse disorder.
- Johnson County residents who are in crisis and experiencing acute psychological distress that may result in an intensive level of service, such as, hospitalization.
